

BOARD THE TROLLEY

With your bike at any station



Watch for this bike sticker on the trolley doors. The sticker shows where to board the trolley with your bike.

When the Trolley is moving, you must stay with your bike, holding on to it, with the kick stand up. Because you're standing, we recommend that you hold on to a pole for your safety.

Please allow passengers to exit the Trolley before you and your bike. Lift your bike as you walk down the steps. We appreciate your care in not bumping Trolley doors or the center hand rails.

Several stations require you to exit from the left-side doors. If a wheelchair lift is present, you won't be able to use the left-side doors. In that situation, wheel your bike up the aisle and get off at the middle doorway.

Always wait until the Trolley has made a complete stop before you move up the aisle. Because Trolley aisles are a little narrow, please take extra care not to bump your bike against passengers or seats.

We appreciate your cooperation

- Sorry, but the Trolley can't accommodate motor powered bikes (gas or electric), mopeds, tandem bicycles, recumbents, tricycles, bikes with training wheels, or bikes with trailers or other attachments.
- For your safety and the safety of other passengers, please walk your bicycle while at a Trolley station.
- For safety reasons, no one under 16 may board the Trolley with a bike. Ages 16 and 17 require parental consent.

Get a special locker for ONE-WAY Biking

Many suburban stations offer free enclosed bicycle lockers. If you don't need your bike at both ends of the Trolley trip, just bike up to the station and park your bike. For bike locker information call 231-BIKE.
