MTS Trolley's Blue, Green & Orange Lines can get you to Qualcomm Stadium for the big games. The **\$5 Day Pass** can be purchased from any Trolley station ticket machine or in advance at The Transit Store at First & Broadway in downtown San Diego. For both games, special expanded Blue Line and Green Line service will operate to the stadium (see reverse for service map).

By 1:00 p.m., Blue and Green Line Trolleys will be arriving at Qualcomm Stadium about every 8 minutes. The Trolley's Qualcomm Stadium Station is just steps away from the Gate K entrance.

Following the game, Blue and Green Line trains will provide continuous departures until crowds have cleared. When you leave Qualcomm Stadium, look for signs and Customer Service Representatives to help you to the correct platform.

Bowl Games Travel Tips:

- Avoid rush hour congestion, travel early, allow plenty of time to get to the stadium to enjoy the pre-game festivities.
- Enjoy post-game presentations and avoid the crowds leaving the stadium immediately after the game.
- Purchase a Day Pass before boarding to expedite your post-game trip.
- For the **Holiday Bowl**, on game day, ticket booths at select downtown and Mission Valley stations will be selling Holiday Bowl Commemorative Day Passes for unlimited Trolley rides (while supplies last). Before game day, these passes will be available at the **Transit Store** at First & Broadway in downtown San Diego, M-F from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

BIG BAY BALLOON PARADE

Wednesday, December 30, 2009 @ 10 a.m.

In conjunction with the **Holiday Bowl**, the **Big Bay Balloon Parade** will highlight the pre-game festivities. Take any Orange, Blue or Green Line train to either the America Plaza or Santa Fe Depot stations; each only a short distance to the parade route on Harbor Drive. Special Event trains will begin operating from the stadium via Mission Valley and Old Town beginning at 7:55 a.m., and at 8:10 a.m. from Old Town.
