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MINUTES

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Mr. Dan McCaslin called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. A roll call sheet listing the committee members in attendance is included (see Attachment A).

2. Approval of March 21, 2013 and June 13, 2013 Meeting Minutes

It was moved and seconded to approve the March 21, 2013 and June 13, 2013 meeting minutes.

3. Public Comment

Ms. Gloriadean Strickland stated that she attended the last meeting, and is an advocate for the seniors of San Diego. Ms. Strickland stated that her driver was late for a trip, and that she is not receiving door-to-door service.

Ms. Lorraine Leighton commented that the buses have malfunctioning ramps, and the buses do not have air conditioning.

4. Member Comment

Ms. Lisa Madsen noted that at the previous meeting, Connery Cepeda had asked if there was a specific pattern regarding wheelchair pass ups. The data was reviewed over a three month period, and no specific pattern could be determined. The two routes with the most pass ups were Route 3 with 17, and Route 929 with 32.

5. ADA Paratransit Reports

MTS Access - Mr. John Lewis presented the MTS Access reports for July and August 2013 (see Attachment B).

ADARide – Mr. Art Hulscher presented the ADARide certification reports for July and August 2013 (see Attachment C).

6. Fixed-Route Reports

MTS Bus – Ms. Belinda Fragger presented the MTS Bus Ramp Deployment Report for July and August 2013 (see Attachment D).

MTS Contract Services (Veolia Transportation) – Mr. Rene Alvarez presented the MTS Contract Services Ramp Deployment Report for July and August 2013 (see Attachment E).

San Diego Trolley, Inc. – Mr. Tom Doogan presented the San Diego Trolley Lift Deployment Report for the months of July and August 2013 (see Attachment F).

7. Upcoming 2014 Major Service Change Proposals

Mr. Denis Desmond provided information on upcoming major service changes. Major changes are going to affect three routes. The first is the Mid-City rapid bus, which will replace Route 15 between Downtown and SDSU. The second is along the I-15 corridor between Downtown and Escondido. The third will operate during peak hours on weekdays and will operate between the I-15 corridor and UCSD. These three routes will begin operating in summer 2014. As part of these changes, the agency is also looking at possible service adjustments for the other local routes that will interface with these future routes.

Other changes may include Route 950, which is a new express route travelling from Otay Mesa to the Iris Trolley Station. MTS will look at adding more service to the route. The Planning department has been working on talking to passengers, and asking for comments and feedback before providing recommendations to the Board of Directors. Mr. Ruben Ceballos asked if the information was online. Mr. Desmond responded that the information was online on the MTS webpage, and that passengers could provide feedback online as well.

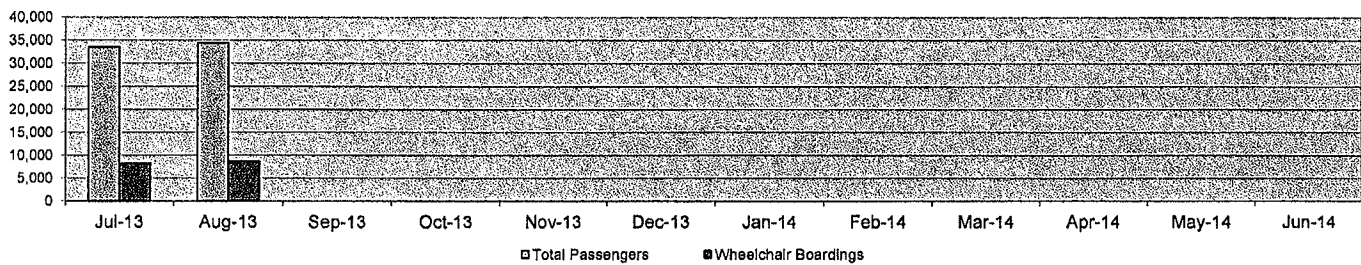

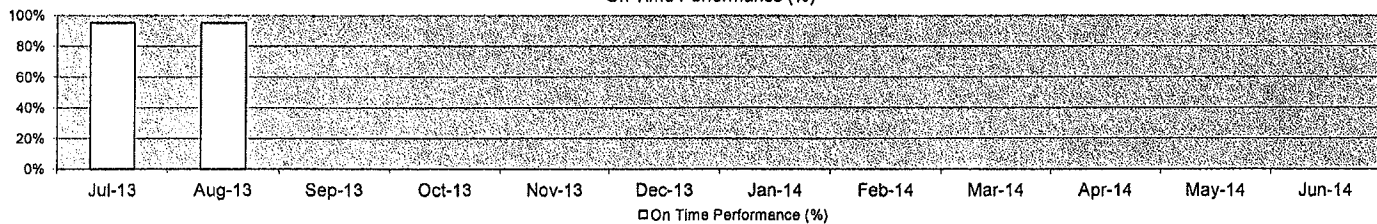

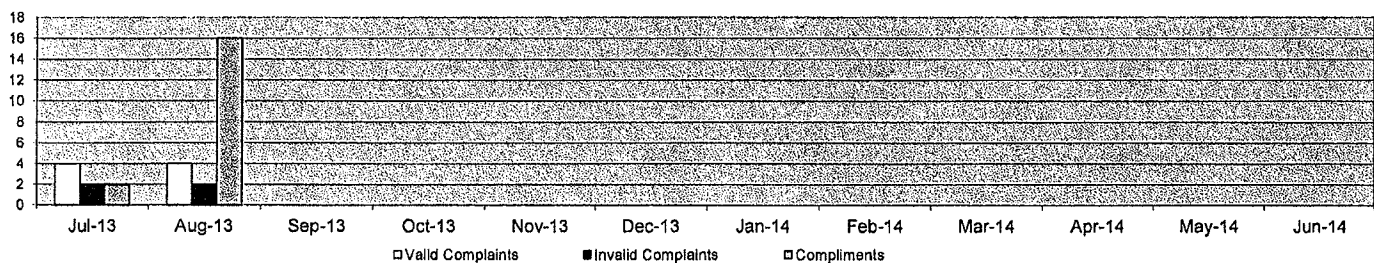
Total Passengers and Wheelchair Boardings
