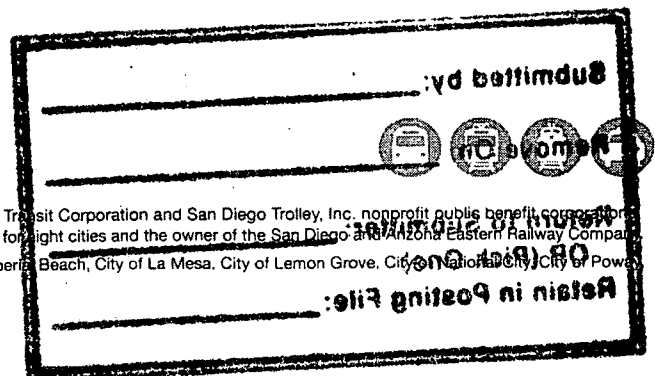

Notice of Public Hearings

PROPOSED CHANGES TO MTS BUS AND ADA PARATRANSIT SERVICES

Notice is hereby given that the Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) will conduct public hearings on March 2, 2006, at 6:00 pm at Golden Hall (San Diego Concourse, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101), on March 8, 2006 at 6:00 pm at the German American Hall (1017 S. Mollison Ave., El Cajon, CA 92020) and on March 9, 2006 at 9:00 a.m. at Golden Hall. The purpose of the public hearings is to consider and approve proposed changes to MTS bus and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) paratransit services, which include routes operated by San Diego Transit Corporation, MTS Contract Services, National City Transit, Chula Vista Transit, MTS Access, and MTS Suburban Paratransit.

Fixed-route bus changes are designed to increase overall ridership, reduce travel time, and maximize system efficiencies by restructuring many routes, improving frequencies on certain routes with high ridership, and discontinuing route segments with low ridership. ADA paratransit service boundaries would be adjusted in accordance with federal law, which may result in a slight reduction in ADA service area coverage as a result of changes to the fixed-route bus network.

Testimony will be taken at all three meetings, with final action to approve or disapprove the proposed changes to MTS bus and ADA paratransit services taking place during the March 9, 2006 meeting. If approved, the proposals would be implemented starting June 2006. Proposed changes included in the Public Hearing are listed at www.sdcommute.com and on Take Ones aboard MTS bus and trolley vehicles. A Take One can also be obtained via mail by calling 619-231-1466.

Dear Transit Committee,

I am writing this letter to express my concern over the proposed elimination of the 856 and 858 bus routes.

My primary concern is as a full-time faculty member in the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District who sees the potential impact of these proposed changes on the lives of low-income and disabled students and on the district as a whole. I am, however, also troubled as a legally blind citizen of San Diego who often relies on public transportation to get to and from my workplace and to work-related activities.

The 858 currently offers a direct link between the East County's two community colleges: Cuyamaca and Grossmont. This semester, there are 1236 shared students – that is, students who attend classes at both colleges. The elimination of the 858 will mean that those students who travel by bus will no longer be able to go directly from one school to the other. They will have to go to the El Cajon Transit Center and transfer to a second bus. This cannot help but add travel time.

Increased travel time is likely to prevent students from being able to get to class on time. It discourages cross-campus enrollment, it may lengthen the time it takes for students to complete a degree or certificate, it may even cause students who cannot achieve full-time status at either college to drop out. From a transit perspective, a more arduous and time-consuming trip will discourage ridership.

Given that both campuses are under construction and parking is at a premium, surely now is not the time to make travel to and from the schools more difficult. Rather, now is an excellent time to put forth a campaign to increase ridership at both campuses.

The 858 performs an important role in encouraging future enrollment at Cuyamaca and Grossmont and in the long-term development of East County. On my periodic trips to or from my sister school, I have observed many secondary students on the bus in the afternoons. The long-term educational and economic health of East County is surely nurtured by providing junior high/high school to college connections in the way the 858 does for these students. When they look at a route map, they see the two end points are their two, local community colleges. I don't think it is an exaggeration to assert that a seed of educational opportunity is planted every time they look up at the destination sign and see "Grossmont College" or "Cuyamaca College."


Some may ask what difference a twenty or thirty minute increase in ride time could possible have. For anyone with such doubts, I invite you to ride transit with me for just one day.

A twenty to thirty minute increase in a particular trip may seem like little, but let me share a personal example about how the elimination of the other line – the 856 – and an increased ridetime will impact my life. I live near College Grove Shopping Center. My current trip to work involves taking the 936 from College Ave. and University Ave. to to the Grove Shopping Center, and then catching the 856 to Cuyamaca College. This is a trip of less than 10 miles which takes me about 90 minutes, including wait times. With the proposed change, I would take the 936 to Lemon Grove Trolley Station, catch a trolley to Spring Street Station, and then catch the 855 bus to Cuyamaca. That will make my current 90 minute trip take two hours. At that point, the ride to work from College Area to Cuyamaca will take as long as a drive from San Diego to Los Angeles.

I am deeply grateful for the freedom – however limited it may be – that public transit offers the poor and the disabled like myself. I simply ask that you carefully consider the long term impact of the proposed transit changes on the poor and disabled of the area, on the enrollment of the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District, and on the long-term economical and educational health of East County.

My subject is Improving Transportation Service.

On March 9th, a week from Thursday, a decision about public bus transportation will be made that will affect nearly all the citizens of San Diego.

First notification was made last Thursday, February 23, by passouts on the buses and trolleys.

This Thursday, March 2, 2006, the first meeting, a NIGHT meeting will be held at Golden Hall between 6 p.m. and 9 p.m.

The FINAL meeting will be Thursday, March 9, a DAY meeting and will also be held at Golden Hall between 9 a.m. and noon when the vote to approve is scheduled to be taken. Please note: there are only 2 weeks from NOTIFICATION to the FINAL VOTE.

The Green Line contains a trolley stop that is the most user-friendly of them all. Picture a level platform at the trolley level, an elevator on each side of the tracks so there is no crossing of tracks necessary and even the most infirm of people can go from the trolley level to the bus level in a couple of minutes.

At bus level picture another smooth, flat, level platform within 100 feet of most bus stops. Safety is provided for passengers because there is no vehicle traffic except buses and transit vehicles in the bus loading areas. Any bus coming within one quarter of a mile should be routed to this most user-friendly of all stations, GRANTVILLE.

In the GRANTVILLE area, special needs individuals are bussed for supervision Mondays through Fridays, for 6 hours a day. Also, in this area are lots of 24 hour a day, seven day a week residents that include the elderly, the lame, the blind, people with manual wheelchairs and some using walkers, who would like to make more timely connections to get to their destinations on ZION Avenue and beyond.

The special needs caretakers are willing to spend five minutes each trip to stop at GRANTVILLE in order to give the full time residents a better chance to save time in getting to their destinations. Possible savings of time for residents could range from 15 minutes up to an hour and would definitely improve ridership.

The route #14 bus stop at GRANTVILLE Station is scheduled to be DELETED. This bus stop has been in existence for over 8 months, and it MUST be kept for the benefit of the residents of Mission Valley, Grantville, Allied Gardens and Navajo communities.

Riders arriving from El Cajon and Santee that want access to these communities should be given the best opportunity possible to get to their homes and work in the shortest time possible and with the least obstacles.

In the past two days I have collected over 100 signatures of people who will not be able to get to this Thursday nights meeting.

The MTS Board members speak of meeting the needs of the public. This is an opportunity for them to prove it, by voting to keep the #14 bus stop at GRANTVILLE Station.

Nearly every council member here is involved with transportation in this area. Many are on the MTS Board or Sandbag Board and the route is in 2 council member's districts. Will you please support my request to keep the #14 bus stop at GRANTVILLE? Last night the entire Navajo Council members signed my petition. Will you also support my request?

The Green Line contains a trolley stop that is the most user-friendly of them all. Picture a level platform at the trolley level, an elevator on each side of the tracks so there is no crossing of tracks necessary and even the most infirm of people can go from the trolley level to the bus level in a couple of minutes.

At bus level picture another smooth, flat, level platform within 100 feet of most bus stops. Safety is provided for passengers because there is no vehicle traffic except buses and transit vehicles in the bus loading areas. Any bus coming within one quarter of a mile should be routed to this most user-friendly of all stations, GRANTVILLE.

In the GRANTVILLE area, special needs individuals are bussed for supervision Mondays through Fridays, for 6 hours a day. Also, in this area are lots of 24 hour a day, seven day a week residents that include the elderly, the lame, the blind, people with manual wheelchairs and some using walkers, who would like to make more timely connections to get to their destinations on ZION Avenue and beyond.

Here is the compromise. The special needs caretakers are willing to spend five minutes each trip to stop at GRANTVILLE in order to give the full time residents a better chance to save time in getting to their destinations. Possible savings of time for residents could range from 15 minutes up to an hour and would definitely improve ridership.

By making GRANTVILLE Station a bus stop on the Mission Valley to SDSU bus route that will travel in the ZION Avenue corridor, both short term and permanent residents will benefit.

Once you add GRANTVILLE to the route, the challenge will be to improve the timing of connections between the trolley and the bus.

The special needs caretakers use the trolley regularly, now. Give them a good connection between the trolley and the bus, and they will use GRANTVILLE as well.

Also, remember all the SDSU students and the El Cajon and Santee users that would also benefit from a #14 bus stop at GRANTVILLE.

Will you support the addition of GRANTVILLE Station as a bus stop for the proposed #14 bus route and will you accept the challenge of improving the timing of connections from the trolley to the bus?

Will you accept my request, give users good service, and watch your ridership increase, as well as your income?

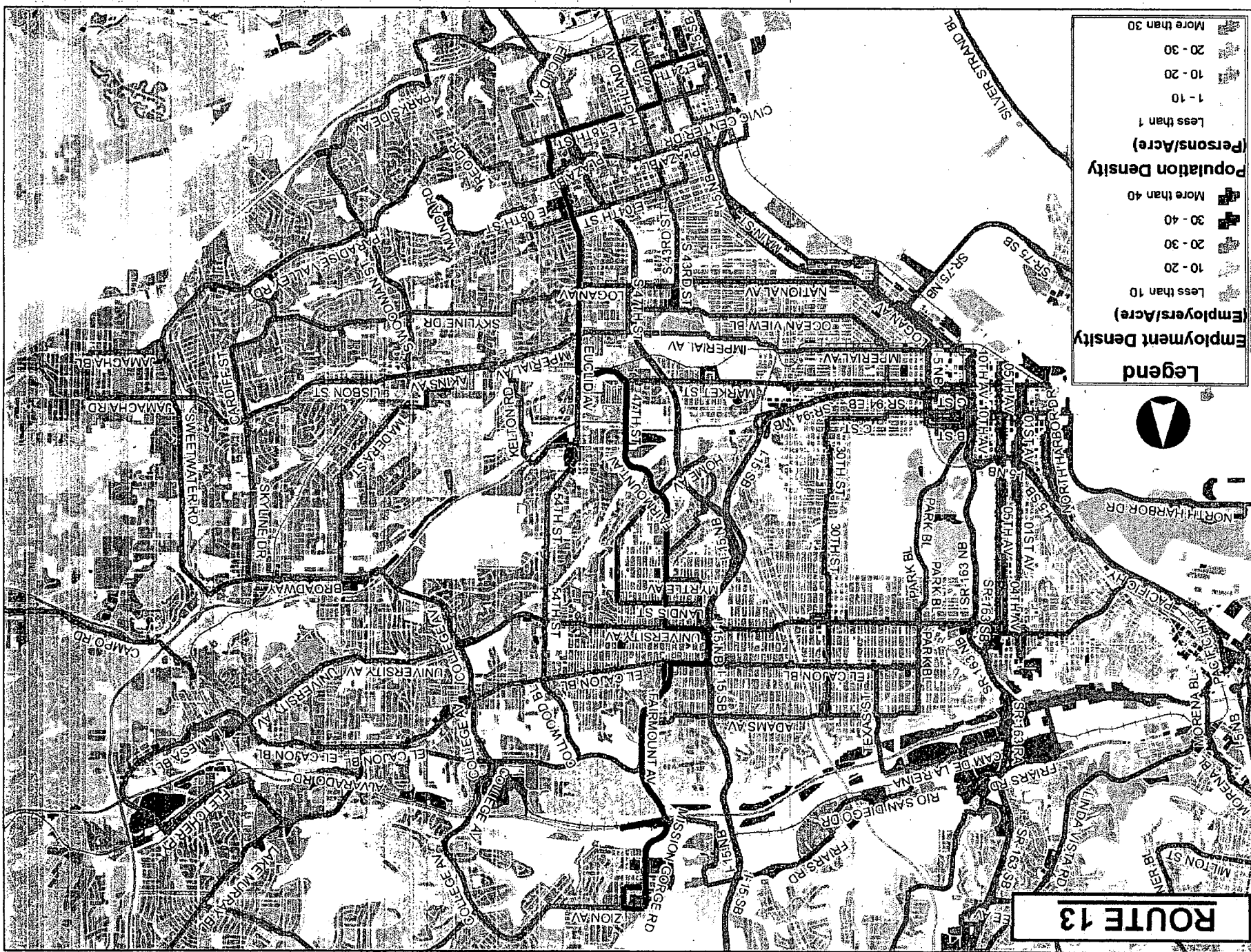

As we get underway with Phase II of the Comprehensive Operational Analysis to restructure MTS Bus services, I am writing to urge you and the Board to not support the proposed elimination of the express Route 210 bus from the Sorrento Mesa area to downtown.

It would be extreme and unjust to abandon this route at a time when the residents use and need this service the most. This route is full of riders, and often so well-used that many have to stand during peak hours. This is substantiated by the attached petition signed by more than 140 riders. These Route 210 users willingly take this bus rather than choosing to clog up freeway arterials with their cars. Getting citizens to use public transit is even more crucial now as commute times and gas prices continue to escalate all over the county.

Should the Board of Directors approve the elimination of Route 210, the result will be devastating. In areas where we do not have alternative public transportation such as trolleys, an efficient mode of transportation such as the 210 is even more critical. When you have public transit that is competitive with cars in getting people from point A to point B, it makes no sense to eliminate it. 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I'm here today because of my concern regarding the proposed route changes the transit authority is considering not only for Linda Vista residents but for the greater community as well.

On December 12th 2005, approximately 50 residents from Linda Vista met with representatives from MTS to address our concerns about changes to route 25 that would impact the community, specifically, elimination of the Osler loop affecting access and safety to many seniors in the area.

MTS has hired consultants at a cost of \$600,000 to produce a plan that would improve efficiency and increase rider ship. However, at that December meeting, I pointed out that the consultant's proposed changes affecting Linda Vista were putting two bus routes (25 and 44) along the same pathway. How is that efficient, and how does that increase rider ship?

From that public comment, the 25 Shuttle was created and reinstated the Osler loop only to eliminate approximately 85% of the remaining route. This short sighted placation on part of MTS to return the loop and create the 25 shuttle is really disconcerting as it eliminates direct access for countless numbers of residents to local grocery stores and businesses in the Claremont area. More importantly, it eliminates direct access to healthcare at Sharp Memorial and Children's Hospitals, Mesa Vista Psychiatric facility, Kaiser Clinic, and Dermatology Associates.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, 78 million of the U.S. population as of 2006 is between the ages of 65-78 trending upwards over the next 20 years. So, greater than 25 percent of the population in San Diego County is in an age group that has increasing difficulties with health, disabilities, and access. Has the board considered the effects of changing and reducing transportation access to this group and meeting their needs for obtaining goods and services?

I feel this decreased access violates the spirit of the law of section and subparts of sections 227, 301 (9), 302, 303 (2) of the ADA act of 1990 by reducing services to the disabled that are currently provided. I also feel these recommendations go against TEA 21.

The "25 Shuttle" experiment will be reviewed in 6 months to determine its viability. In December 2005, the consultants stated they were eliminating the Osler loop because of poor rider ship. In February 2006, they reinstated the Osler loop and eliminated the rest of the 25 route. Has rider ship flip flopped? My concern is there seems to be no consistency in what the consultants recommend. I can't believe this is only occurring in Linda Vista and wonder about the consequences of possible recommendations throughout the entire system. Upon review in 6 months, the board may remove the 25 shuttle altogether leaving only the 44 line to serve Linda Vista residents. This would create a hardship for many.

I understand there is increasing support for expansion of express shuttle routes similar to routes 20, 30, and 50, yet their current operational costs are much more than most other routes. How can the board justify increasing support for these express routes? Can we as citizens of San Diego consider other than what the consultants have proposed for reconfiguration of routes and schedules? Has logistics and operations along with marketing identified other options to improve efficiencies and increase rider ship? If so, what are these options that the community needs to be aware of to provide support for or to help identify alternatives?

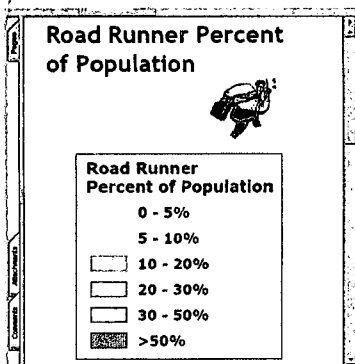


Mission Village Drive Area*



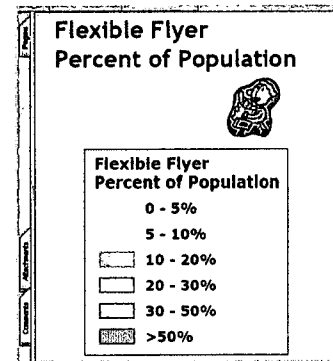

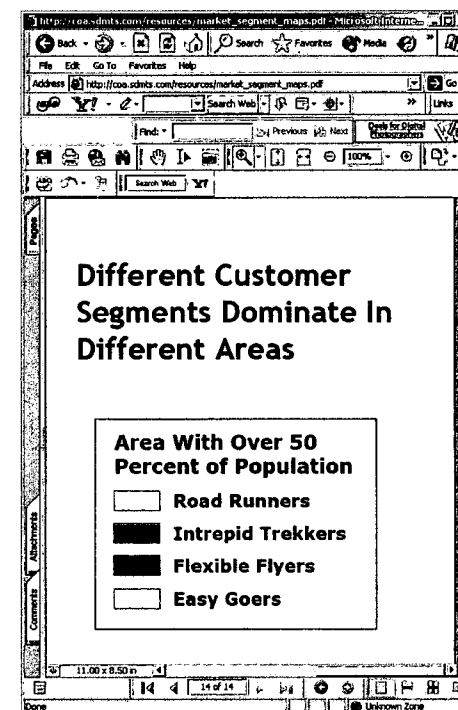

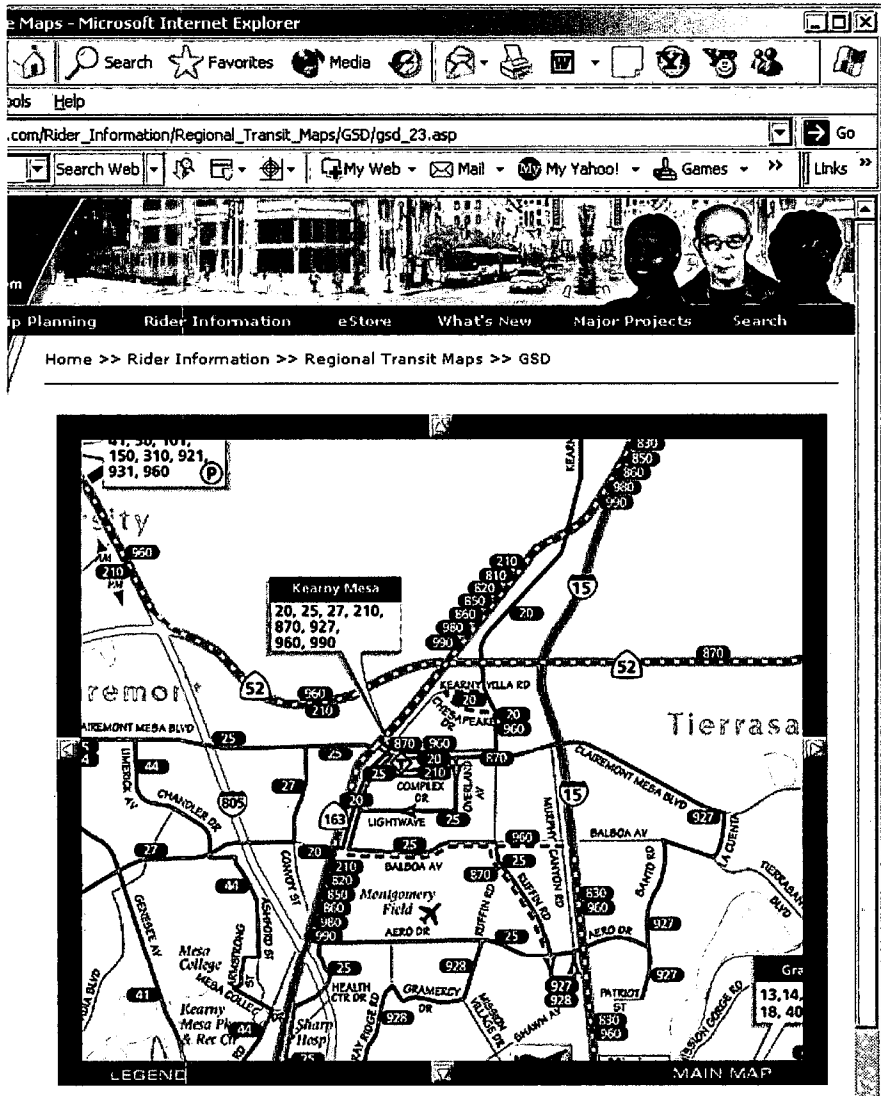

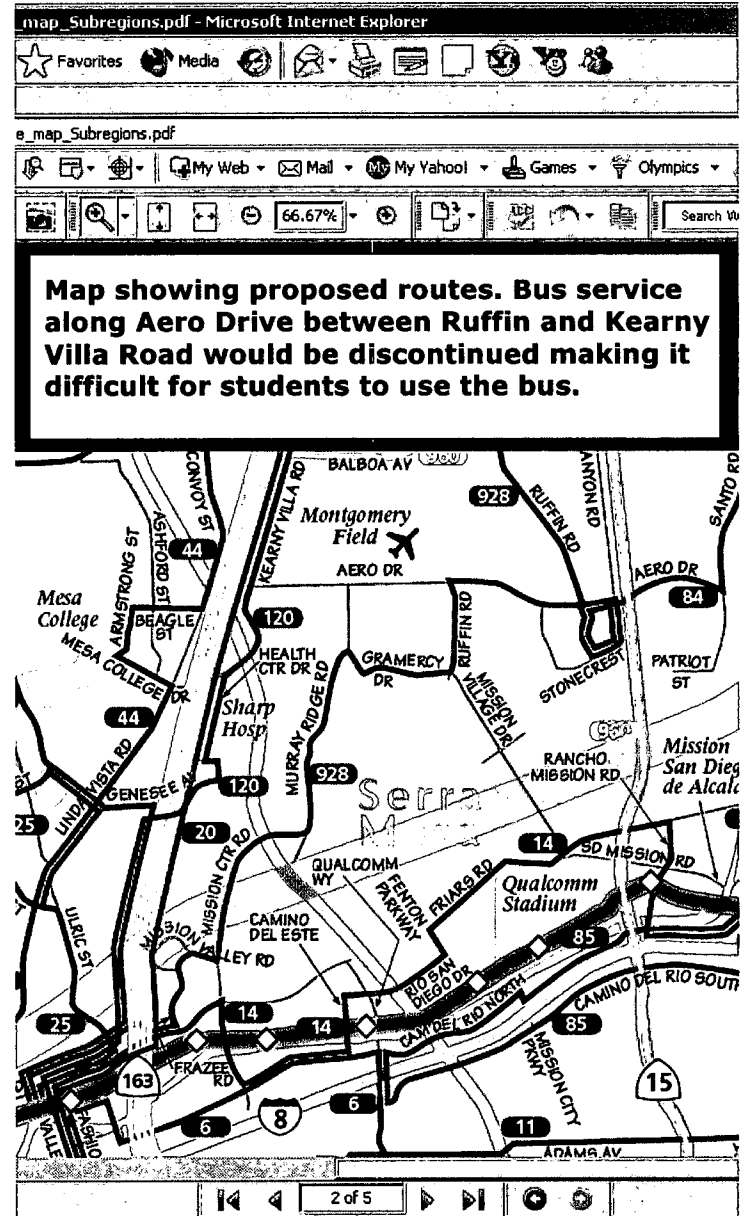

According to a SANDAG Fiscal Year 2004 Transit Service Data report, Bus Route 25 provided transportation to over 921,000 passengers. It ranked ninth in ridership among thirty bus routes. Its operating cost was six dollars and fifty-four cents per revenue mile compared to the average of seven dollars and thirty cents per revenue mile of the entire bus system.

The proposal on the table is to split Bus Route 25.

This disintegration of Bus Route 25 leaves the community of Linda Vista resident with the need to take more than one bus to locations mentioned earlier, important locations such as Sharp Memorial Hospital and Kaiser Permanente Clinic to mention only two.

For example, a trip to Sharp Memorial Hospital and other health care facilities from Comstock Street takes an average of thirteen minutes. The proposal would have the Linda Vista resident take two buses mentioned below and a lot longer length of time to get there.

Lets return to operating cost per revenue mile. For the Linda Vista resident wishing to go to Sharp Memorial Hospital area, MTS is proposing to maintain two routes, the new Bus Route 25 plus the new Bus Route 120L, a combined 12.3 mile stretch. The current Bus Route 25 distance from Fashion Valley Transit Center to Sharp Memorial Hospital and back is 9.2 miles long. The proposed change means a greater distance 3.1 miles longer, greater operating cost, less efficiency, and lower customer satisfaction. The bottom line is NO SAVINGS.

Thus, for both the Linda Vista resident and MTS, to keep the traditional, long standing , low operating cost per revenue mile, ninth among 30 bus routes in total passengers Bus Route 25, is to Be EFFICIENT and to SAVE while offering its riders greater CUSTOMER SATISFACTION.

Remember to KEEP IT GREAT, DO NOT DISINTEGRATE.

Swanson Pool set for closure March 5 – June 11

Account set up to receive tax deductible donations to keep the pool open

Last August, as the City's budget woes came to light, it was announced most city operated pools would close for three and one half months on a rotating basis unless the communities raised the needed funds to keep their pool open. Four pools, Clairemont, Ned Baumer Miramar College Aquatic Center, Memorial and Vista Terrace will remain open throughout the year. While two of the pools received grants, an anonymous donor contributed \$102,000 to cover the \$100,000 needed to keep the Clairemont pool open.

Time is running out to keep Swanson Pool from closing March 5 – June 11. It was recently learned that University City would have to raise \$97,000, not the \$80,000 as first thought, to keep Swanson Pool open for the entire period. The funds may be raised through donations, sponsorships, grants and/or rentals. Individuals, organizations and companies may rent the pool for private functions including company parties. If a partial

amount is raised, the pool will remain open as long as the funds allow. An account, Park and Recreation Donation Fund - Swanson Pool, has been set up to receive tax deductible donations. Contact Madeleine Baudoin in Scott Peters office at 619-235-7293 or mbaudoin@sandiego.gov for more information about donating funds. An anonymous donor recently donated \$1000 to start the fund. Please help spread the word.

University City residents formed an assessment district in the early '70's to build the Rec Center and pool. Thousands of people have learned to swim at Swanson Pool, and people of all ages continue to use the pool on a regular basis for exercise, recreation and instruction. Confused About Those Year-End Library Mailings?

You were in good company if you wondered why you got so many requests for year-end financial support from the Library! With the budget cuts and money problems at the City of San Diego, many of our city services have been cut back significantly. This is definitely the case with library services. Book and other media purchases are limited, and you've probably noticed that the library is open fewer hours, too.

To supplement its budget, the main fund-raising department of the San Diego Public Library sent out a request for donations which you probably received with your water statement in November or December. At about the same time, you may have received a request for a donation from the main office of the Friends of the San Diego Public Library. To further complicate things, you also may have received an envelope for payment of your membership dues to our local Friends of the SDPL.

What's the difference between them,

you might ask. To go right to the bottom line, if you want your funds to go for purchase of equipment, books, and special programs for children and adults at the University Community branch, you need to put "University Community" on your check. This will assure that your donation will be allocated to our University City branch. Without this notation, money goes into the general fund of the San Diego Public Library, to be used for the benefit of all the branches.

When you are asked to renew your membership in the Friends of the SDPL, you'll note that our reply envelope is already pre-stamped with "University Community." Joining the local Friends group assures you of advance notice of our book sales, and you also get the newsletter 3-4 times a year.

Whether you join the Friends, make a donation, or make a purchase at our silent auction or book sale, we appreciate your support of the local library very much.

Construction to Begin on Inner Circle at UC Village Apartments

On October 3, 2000, the City Council approved expansion of the 510 unit senior housing complex, **University City Village Apartments**, located on a 75 acre site between, Governor Dr. and SR-52 west of I-805. Approval was given to add 599 units including 80 assisted living units and fifteen units of affordable senior housing.

The complex is now owned by two separate corporations, and each is entitled to build a portion of the additional units approved. The units in the complex are often referred to as the "inner circle" (University City Village Apartments) and the "outer" (Town Park Villas) reflecting the separate ownership.

The first phase of construction is scheduled to begin at University City Village apartments (inner circle) the end of February or beginning of March. This phase will consist of adding a second story on 3 buildings and the demolition of a building to construct a new recreation building.

There will be approximately 30 new apartment homes in this phase—new 1 bedroom units and 2 bedroom 2 bath units with a loft. The new recreation building will have the offices for manager and leasing along with an exercise room, library, movie theater room, laundry facilities, large kitchen and a huge great room for parties and social events. A new pool and spa will be built next to the recreation building as well as the men's and women's bathroom and shower facilities.

Plans call for approximately 2 more phases consisting of the addition of a second story on approximately 10 more buildings and the construction of 9 new buildings. If construction goes according to plan, the University City Village Apartment portion of the complex should be completed in approximately 3 years.

At press time, no information was available regarding plans for the "outer" apartments, Town Park Villas.

Dear Chairman Mathis and Members of the Metropolitan Transit System Board of Directors:

I am writing on behalf of the City Heights Community Development Corporation (CHCDC) to provide comments on the proposed Metropolitan Transit Service (MTS) Service Development Plan. CHCDC has been represented on both the MTS Comprehensive Operational Analysis (COA) Advisory Committee and the SANDAG Mid City Transit Network Advisory Committee. We support the major principles and objectives of each of these efforts.

Our main priority in promoting an efficient transit network regionally and within the Mid City sub region is to get residents of City Heights and Greater Mid City to work and then to other important destinations necessary for an improved quality of life. The I-15 corridor is the main artery to achieve those objectives.

With respect to the Service Development Plan, we support what we understand to be one of the main objectives driving the recommended route changes: consolidate services to enhance the service on the highest demand routes. While this may appear to result in a contraction of diversity of services, our understanding is that your premise is to contract the diversity of routes, destinations and stops in order to strengthen some routes and thereby strengthen the ability of the MTS organization and services to grow in the future. We support a strategic pruning to enable new and healthy growth in the future.

One of our key objectives over the past twenty five years, with the founding of CHCDC and the commencement of the completion of the I-15/SR-15 freeway segment through Mid City San Diego has been to ensure that the freeway will include features that will enhance the revitalization of Mid City and stimulate investment. The Memorandum of Understanding executed between the City of San Diego and the State of California for this project on August 9, 1993 expressly provides for LRT or express bus service in the center median of the freeway.

In anticipation of these promised services, we helped design and promote the interim off-ramp bus stops at El Cajon Blvd and University Avenue and we are pleased that there are presently three commuter routes serving these bus stops and an additional express route entering the freeway at University Avenue. Some variant of those routes needs to continue, especially those providing quick access to downtown as well as linking to key employment centers in the north. For this reason, we support the proposal to maintain and eventually increase service on the Route 960, linking the Euclid Trolley Station to north city employment centers via Mid-City I-15 stops.

At the same time, we are distressed at the proposed elimination of the Routes 40, 830 and 70 which currently serve these stations and Mid-City. This proposal results in the loss of 14 morning express trips to downtown and a similar number returning in the afternoon/evening hours. While we fully understand that the current economics of these routes may not justify retention under the principles of the COA, our shortest remaining link to downtown will be a 45-minute trip on the Route 7 versus a 10-minute trip on one of the discontinued express routes. We do not believe this will fulfill the MTS objective of attracting "choice" riders and it will not conform to the principles of smart growth and transit oriented development that have attracted public and private investments to the Mid-City.

We request that MTS explore the possibility of routing one of the northern I-15 corridor services that presently enter downtown via Highway 163 to continue along the I-15 through and serving the interim stops (and eventually the in-line center median stations) located in Mid-City. We believe that a key direct transit link for the Mid-City communities to downtown via the I-15 corridor could be preserved, while increasing ridership and realizing considerable budgetary savings.

As you may know, we are promoting the early completion of the promised in line median stations to be accessed via improvements leading to the Transit Gateways at each of these two main East-West corridor over-crossings. We are referring to the I-15 in line route as the "Center Line" and one of the key planned components of the Mid City Transit Network stretching from SDSU to Downtown via El Cajon Boulevard and Park Blvd. as the "Cross Town Express".

It is important that any route changes regionally are part of a strategy to use these two key Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) elements. We see the I-15 North-South Corridor as a great economic "river" that will carry residents to jobs and bring business to Mid City. We appreciate your support in accelerating the completion of these BRT routes and we look forward to working with you in the future in bringing the promise of a "Transit First" strategy to reality for the San Diego region.

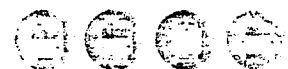

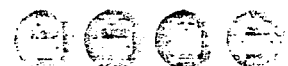

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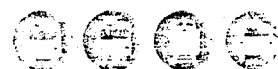
