B. License for Private Crossings - D and E Streets in Chula Vista on the Coronado Branch

Tim Allison submitted and reviewed an informational report regarding an easement for an underground gas pipeline crossing (attached to the agenda item). Ms. Landers commented that this is the typical case where eminent domain could be used against SD&AE.

Action Taken

Mr. Domen moved to approve issuing an easement to San Diego Gas & Electric Co. (SDG&E) for an underground gas pipeline crossing the SD&AE right of way at 65th Street in the City of San Diego. Mr. Jones seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.
