

PUBLIC HEARING: Route 910 – Overnight Bus Service

The San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) Board of Directors will hold a Public Hearing to establish the Route 910 (Overnight Express) as a permanent route. Route 910 is a pilot route launched in January 2025 that runs from the U.S. - Mexico border to downtown San Diego overnight when the UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley cannot operate. Route 910 operates approximately 12:30am-5am, with stops in San Ysidro, South San Diego, Chula Vista, National City, Barrio Logan and Downtown San Diego. A standard transit fare applies for Route 910, and the travel time is competitive with the Trolley. If approved, Route 910 will be made permanent.
