

The San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) Board of Directors will hold a Public Hearing for the discontinuation of the Route 110 (Mira Mesa Express – Downtown San Diego). Route 110 provides express service between Mira Mesa and Downtown San Diego via Miramar College Transit Station, with four trips to Downtown in the morning and four trips to Mira Mesa in the afternoon. The route has the lowest average boardings per weekday, passengers per revenue hour, and farebox recovery ratio when compared to other MTS Express and Rapid Express Services.

The Route has duplicative service with Route 921 (on Mira Mesa Boulevard) and Rapid 235 (service between Miramar College Transit Station and Downtown). To mitigate the discontinuation of Route 110, MTS will add two additional Route 921 trips in the morning that will operate with similar spans as current Route 110 morning trips and will add Miramar College Transit Station as a stop to Rapid Express 290 for customers that want a faster alternative to downtown than Rapid 235. Customers will be able to take Route 921 or Rapid 237 to Miramar College Transit Station and transfer to Rapid 235 or Rapid Express 290 in the morning and vice versa in the afternoon.
