

SAN DIEGO METROPOLITAN TRANSIT SYSTEM

Amendments to MTS Ordinance No. 11

The San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) Board of Directors will review proposed amendments to MTS Ordinance No. 11 “An Ordinance Providing for the Licensing and the Regulating of Transportation Services Within the City and County by the Adoption of a Uniform Paratransit Ordinance”. If approved, the action by MTS Board of Directors would be to adopt the proposed amendments to MTS Ordinance No. 11, which involve revising various For-Hire Vehicle regulatory requirements. This includes, but is not limited to, removing language relating Sheriff Driver Identification Card requirements that are handled by the Sheriff, removing the requirement for applicants to disclose rates of fare during the permit application process, removing the right to appeal the fee schedule, clarifying requirements relating to Airport Access Fees and trips into private property, revising requirements for taxicab interior postings, adding requirement to accept contactless credit card payments and offer electronic receipts, removing prohibition on soliciting trips from private businesses, removing language relating to permit transfers and taxicab stand filing fee, and other minor changes.

The MTS Board of Director’s Meeting will be held on June 18, 2026 at 9:00a.m., James R. Mills Building, 10TH Floor, Board Meeting Room; 1255 Imperial Avenue, San Diego, CA, 92101-7490.
