Submitting Your Bid via BidWeb on Self Service

MTS has received new software to help bus operators bid via a website.

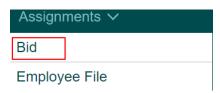
Even if you submit your bid via this website, it will be treated the same as a paper bid slip. If your choices are incomplete or insufficient, we must skip you to continue the bidding process. We recommend that you still attend via Zoom or in person at your appointment time as we process your submitted bid.

As the software is new, if you have any questions or if you experience any issues, please take a picture or video with your phone or screenshot it and send them to Devin Braun. (devin.braun@sdmts.com) It is important to give specifics of what is wrong in order to follow up. You may also let your dispatcher know.

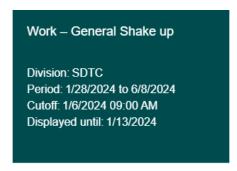
Bidding on Web Procedures and How-To for Round 1

Login to Self Service at https://selfservice.sdmts.com. If you get locked out or don't know your password, please call the dispatch office.

At the top of the page, Select "Bid" in the dropdown menu.



Then select the "Work – General Shake up" bid tile.



Filling out a bid online is like filling out a paper bid slip. You choose the runs that you want to put together and submit them as a weekly selection. Each of these is called a "Week scenario". Each Week Scenario must contain your requested days off and five days of work. You can enter/change your choices until the Cutoff time shown.

Keep in in mind that when the bids are processed, they are evaluated in the order you submit your scenarios, line-byline. The ENTIRE WEEK must be available in order to be awarded. If one day or day off is not available, the line is skipped and we go to the next line.

Add a Work Scenario

To begin filling out your bid, select Add Work Scenario

Select Your Role

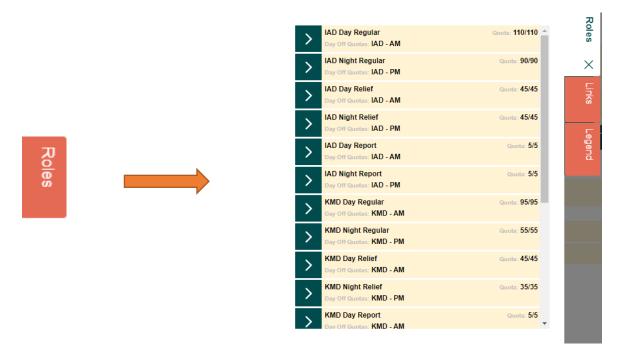
The first step of each scenario is to select the "Role" at the top of the page. This is where you will bid your week. For example, if you would normally say "IAD Days" at bidding, then choose "IAD Day Regular" if you are going to bid your full week with duties every day. If you are going to bid during relief bidding or you are only going to bid some of your days and remain extra board until the next round, select a "Relief" role.



If you want to bid on the Vacation Board, be sure to select the correct Division and day/night category.

Select your Days Off

After selecting your role, you can choose your days off. If you want to see what is still available, go to the "Roles" tab on the left side to see how many of each combo are still remaining. You may need or want to change your role by seeing this information.



On the days of the week for your scenario, select one of the tabs for the days you want to take off then press the button. The combinations including that day off are shown and how many are still available. If you see the combination you want, add it to your scenario by clicking on the thumbs up symbol . Important...if you select a weekday work assignment after selecting days off that include a weekday, it will overwrite your days off. Make sure that you have two (2) days off and five (5) working days for each scenario.

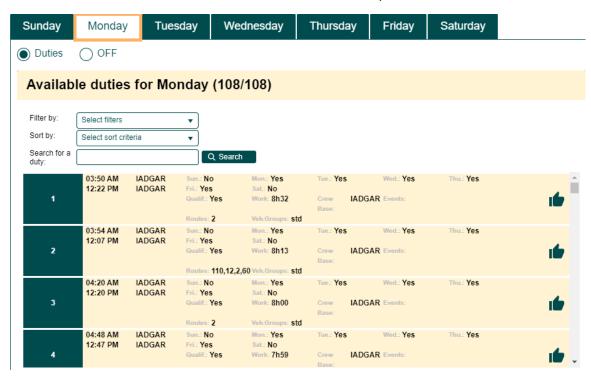


After you select your days off, they will be shown in your scenario.



Fill In Your Work Week

Select the work for the week. In this case, we will select Monday-Friday. In Round 1 of bidding, you must select the same duty for each weekday. The program will fill this out automatically when you select a duty. To begin, press a Day of the Week tab to show what work is still available on that day:



You can sort the work that is available by changing the sort values above. Examples that you can sort by are:



Identifier	The Duty/Run Number						
Start	The starting time						
End	The ending time						
Work	How much actual working time there is in the day.						
Crew Base	IAD or KMD						
Veh Groups	The type of vehicle. • std, RP40 = 40 foot, Rapid 40 foot • art = articulated • brt1/brt2 = Rapid articulated						

You can also use the filter to show only Straight or Split duties.



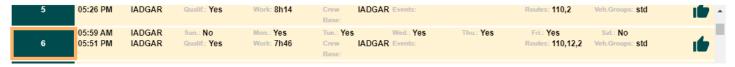
Click on the "x" next to a filter or sort order to remove it.

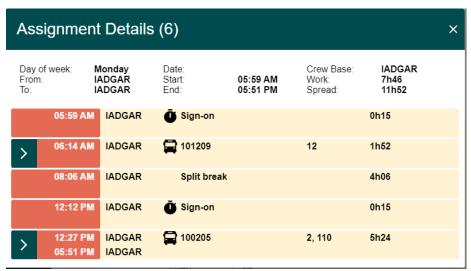


Make sure to hit "Apply" when adding/removing a sort order or filter.



You can search through the list of available runs/duties based on your preferences. If you click on a Run/Duty number, it will show you the details of that Run/Duty.

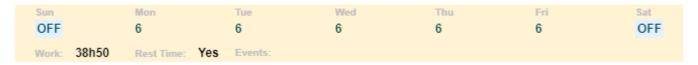






If you want to add this duty to your scenario, press the Thumbs Up button

Here is the scenario with all of the days filled out.



If you have completed your scenario and all days are filled out, make sure to click the Done button. If you don't click on "Done", it's not saved!



You can add as many scenarios as you'd like. This is just like filling out your bid slip. You must fill out enough entries so that if your top choices aren't available, you have other choices to process.

Here is a bid with 4 difference choices. They will be processed in order during bidding. You can choose as many scenarios as you'd like. After you create these scenarios, if you want to change the order of your preferences, just drag and drop them into the correct order.

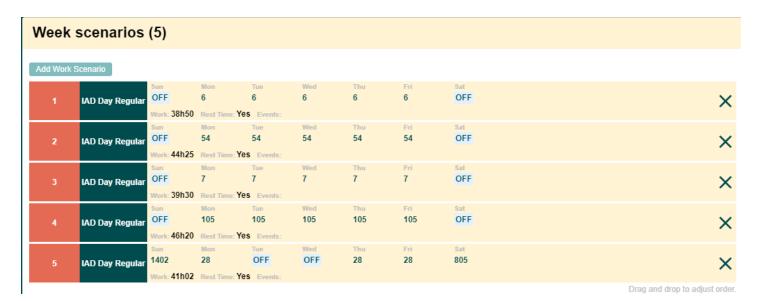


If you want to edit any scenario, just click that line to edit it. Clicking on the "X" will remove it.

Selecting Scenarios with Weekdays and Weekend Duties/Runs (at least one weekday off)

If your day off combination includes a weekday, you will be working at least one weekend day. Be sure to submit a Duty/Run for each day of the week.

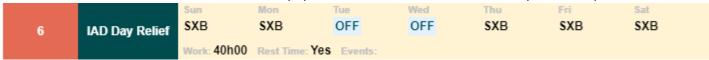
Due to a bug with the software, make sure to select your weekday runs, THEN select your days off. When you select a weekday run, it will overwrite the Days Off if you selected them first. Make sure that all of your scenarios have 5 days of work and 2 days off. If not, the scenario will be invalid.



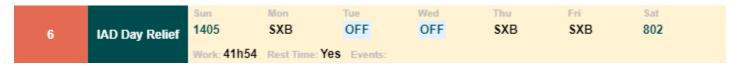
Signifying Relief Bidding in Round 1

If you want to do relief bidding after Round 1, make sure you select a role that includes the word "Relief" for your division and day/night category.

The scenario will be filled out with SXB for all days you want to work and with "OFF" for your bid days off.



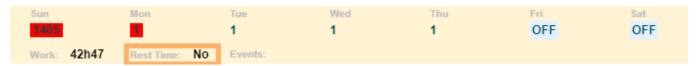
You can bid your weekends in this round and leave weekdays as SXB to fill in for Round 2 in Relief Bidding. Remember to submit many scenarios with the same days off and different weekend duties to make multiple selections.



For example, here are 4 scenarios with the same Run on Sunday (1405) and different Runs on Saturday. They will be processed in order and only will be awarded if the **ENTIRE WEEK** is available. If one run on a line isn't available, it will be skipped. It is important to submit many choices so you are awarded one of your choices.

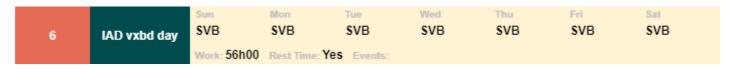

If you select a scenario that does not have enough rest time, the Run numbers will be highlighted in red and the Rest Time will say "No". This is an invalid scenario and must be edited.



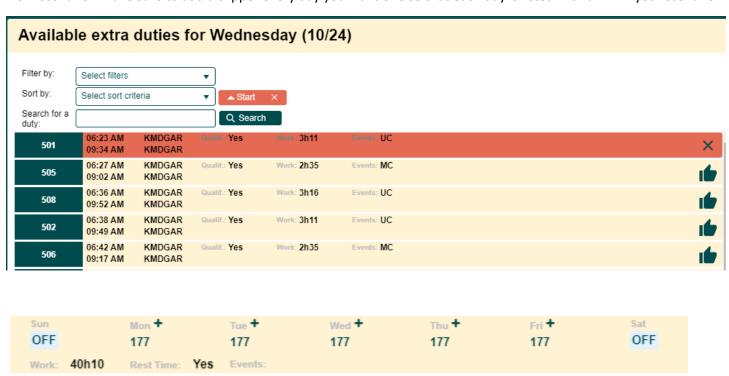
Vacation Board

If you want to work vacation board (SVB), select the Role for IAD or KMD night/day vacation board. You do not need to select any days off.



Bidding a Tripper

If you want to bid a tripper, any available trippers are called "Available extra duties" and you can also add them to your work scenario. Make sure to add a tripper every day you want one so that each day is listed with a "+" in your scenario:



Holiday Scenarios

We will **NOT** be bidding holidays, leave all of the holidays blank. If you fill it out, it will not be processed. At a later time, these will be bid the week before the holiday by those eligible to bid.



Submitting Your Work Scenario Bid

When you have completed filling out all of your work scenarios, you will get a receipt. The receipt means that everything is complete and submitted. You may send yourself an email of the receipt of print it for your records. If you do not get the receipt screen, your bid has not been submitted.

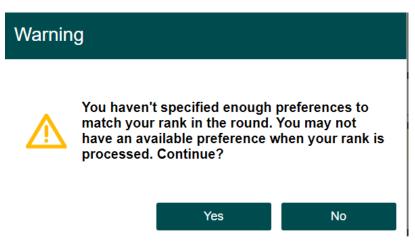

After you submit your work scenarios, you can change them until it is your time to bid.

If you receive this message when submitting your scenarios, you have not submitted enough choices based on the bidding rank for the round you are in. For example, if you are 25th to bid but you only submit 20 choices, you don't have enough choices if the first 20 are taken. You will be required to select a valid choice during bidding via voice (in-person or on Zoom) if your BidWeb choices are incomplete or insufficient. If you are not in the meeting, we must skip you.



Processing Bid Work Scenarios

As bids are processed by the supervisors in the bid room, you can continue to reload your work scenarios. If any part of your work scenario is not available anymore, it will be turn red and show as unavailable. You can either delete the scenario or edit it. It will be skipped during bid processing because the entire week is not available.

Round 2 - Relief Bidding

When relief bidding is available, you will see another tile in the Bid page of Self Service. You can submit/change your choices until the Cutoff time shown.



Your Role (division and day/night category), your days off, and any runs you successfully bid in Round 1 will show as your "Current Work".

Current work



In relief bidding, you will fill in each day of extra board ("SXB") with a run. You may also choose to stay on extra board for any days. Keep in mind that if you do not bid something and remain extra board, you may be assigned runs if they are left over at the end of bidding, per the collective bargaining agreement.

Just like Round 1, you will create Work Scenarios for each day. Begin by selecting

Add Work Scenario

Click on each day of the week and fill in a run for that day by using the thumbs up button . If your selected run is compatible with any trippers, you may also add a tripper through the "Available extra duties" dialog.



One you have filled in each day (or left some SXB if desired), remember to click

Done

Here is an example of a completed week scenario. You can add as many scenarios as you'd like. Remember that if any of the runs on any day is not available the entire scenario will be invalid and will be skipped during bid processing. You may create many scenarios and combinations of workweeks. As bidding is processed, any run that is unavailable will be highlighted in red so you know to edit or delete the scenario.
